

Builder's licence suspended as liquidators take over

THE Queensland Building and Construction Commission has cancelled the building licence of a Peregian Beach-based builder in the hands of liquidators.

Interim commissioner Kellie Lowe said directors in charge of Bush and Beach Homes faced exclusion action.

"We had initially suspended the licence of Bush and Beach Homes on 29 July immediately upon hearing of the company's financial position," Ms Lowe said.

Anyone with concerns about incomplete or defective work performed by Bush and Beach Homes was encouraged to call the commission on 139 333.

She urged sub-contractors and suppliers who believed they were owed money by Bush and Beach Homes to contact the appointed liquidators, Worrells Solvency and Forensic Accountants on 5459 1000.
