



Lake Macquarie bowling club takes back control

A small Lake Macquarie bowling club that was placed into administration last month, has had control of the company returned to its board of directors.

Worrells Solvency and Accountants were appointed administrators to the Burwood Colliery Bowling Club at Whitebridge after a meeting of the board in August.

The bowling club, which overlooks Dudley Beach, continued to operate while the administrators assessed its options.

The administrators say a deed of company arrangement has been signed which provides for the payment of creditors' claims in full.

In a statement, the administrators say the company has continued to trade strongly through its appointment period and events and functions that were booked prior to its appointment, have been honoured.

It says the bowling club has functions booked into the New Year including an event involving well-known Newcastle band The Screaming Jets.
